MESSAGE FROM THE CHAIR & Executive Director

2009 started out with much uncertainty. There was volatility in financial markets, foundations across Canada were reducing and, in some cases, eliminating grants for the year, and our local economy was significantly affected. However, even in these uncertain times, we accomplished much.

We are committed to our donors; committed to preserving their original gifts. We also have an obligation to our community organizations, since they rely on our grants to carry out projects and activities. The performance of our funds is at the very core of how the Community Foundation operates, and our Board has been monitoring this closely. Although our endowment funds were affected by the 2008 – 2009 downturn in the markets, we saw some relatively significant returns on our investments throughout 2009.

With the help of our generous donors, we paid out \$46,000 in grants to charitable initiatives in our community last year. We also organized three significant community events. The first was the Orillia Air Show featuring the Canadian Forces Snowbirds, viewed by an estimated 30,000+ spectators; the second, Random Act of Kindness Day, where more than 5,000 people participated in building community spirit; and third, the Dragon Boat Festival, which saw an additional \$45,000 pledged to local community initiatives. We were also invited to participate in various round table discussions about the future of our community.

This past year saw the creation of two brand new endowment funds: “The Couchiching Conservancy Land Stewardship Endowment Fund” and “The Orillia Volunteer Firefighter’s Disaster Relief Endowment Fund.” It is a privilege for us at the Foundation to be working with these two organizations to further support their efforts in our community.

Because of our generous donors, we were able to deposit a total of \$68,000 into our endowment funds. This money will be community capital forever, providing grants to support important community initiatives in perpetuity.

We also introduced a new logo in 2009, along with some updated marketing materials and are about to launch a brand new website.

A heartfelt thanks goes to our many supportive donors, including the Ontario Trillium Foundation, whose grant over this past year helped our Foundation accomplish so much more.

And finally, thank you to our Board of Directors and Committee members, and the hundreds of volunteers who have moved, and continue to, move the Foundation forward for the betterment of our great community. A special thank you and farewell goes to long-time Board Member and Past-Chair, Christine Manners, who completes her term with us this year. Her involvement with the Foundation has had a significant and truly positive impact on this community and will continue to have an impact for generations to come.

As we move into this next year, we look forward to continuing to work with our many community partners, donors and volunteers on “Strengthening our Community!”

COMMUNITY ENDOWMENT FUNDS

The Community Unrestricted Endowment Fund

The Community Endowment Fund enables the Foundation to respond to areas of urgency within our community. The income is distributed in the form of grants recommended by the Grants Committee and approved by the Board of Directors, in response to applications received from various community organizations.

Apprenticeship Bursary Fund

This is a scholarship fund in memory of the late, Bob Fletcher, and will be awarded in support of a local second or third year apprentice.

Carol Ivey Victim Crisis Service Fund

This fund established by Carol Ivey provides an annual gift to support the ongoing administration and operating costs for North Simcoe Victim Crisis Services.

Casino Rama Festive Fund

This endowment fund was established by the CREW at Casino Rama to help local non-profit groups assist the less fortunate during the festive season.

Couchiching Conservancy Land Stewardship Endowment Fund—NEW

This Stewardship Fund has been created to help the Couchiching Conservancy care for important lands in our area. The Fund provides the financial support that is needed to protect and preserve these lands on an ongoing basis.

Orillia Soldier's Memorial Hospital Foundation Doctor Recruitment Endowment Fund

This endowment fund is used to assist community groups in attracting doctors to establish their practices in the Orillia area.

Ontario Endowment For Children And Youth In Recreation Fund

In partnership with the Province of Ontario, we established this fund to provide a stable, ongoing source of funding to address the recreational and cultural needs of young people.

Orillia Volunteer Firefighters Community Disaster Relief Fund—NEW

This fund, created by the Orillia Volunteer Firefighters Association, assists North Simcoe Victim Crisis Services, the Salvation Army and the Canadian Red Cross with serving individuals and families that have been affected by a personal tragedy such as a devastating fire destroying their home.

Orillia Y's Men's Scholastic Award

This fund was established by The Orillia Y's Men's Club in 2006 and recognizes strong academic achievement and community/school involvement. It provides a cash award for a total of four students: one graduate from each of the 4 high schools in Orillia.

Salvation Army Camp Newport Fund

This endowment fund was established to send local children to Camp Newport recognizing that quality recreation plays a significant role in the healthy development of children and youth.

Simcoe College Scholarship & Bursary Award Fund

Established by Georgian College through funds received from the Simcoe College Foundation, this Fund is awarded to enhance higher education opportunities and to increase access to Georgian College programs for students from Orillia and Area.

The Patti Cox Memorial Children's Fund

This endowment fund was established to assist and support children and children's activities in the Orillia area that focus mainly on personal development that will last a lifetime.

The Patti Cox Memorial Senior's Fund

This endowment fund was established to assist and support seniors and seniors' activities in the Orillia area that focus on improving levels of independence and self-sufficiency.

They Had a Dream Fund (Administration Endowment)

In order to maintain an acceptable level of administration costs on the various funds, an Administration Endowment Fund was established to support the operating and administration of The Community Foundation of Orillia & Area. This Fund is named "They Had a Dream Fund" in honour of two of the Foundation's founders, Mr. Jim Dykes and Mr. Ken Koyama.

Tom Parish Scholarship Fund

This is a scholarship given annually to an Orillia high school graduate who will be attending a college or university to continue studies in Tourism, Marine Biology, Business or Environmental studies, in memory of the late Tom Parish.

Trails For Life Endowment Fund

A permanent endowment fund to help maintain Orillia's Trails For Life, a 10 kilometre multi-use paved trail built in 2000 as part of the Millennium celebrations.

YMCA Skid Watson Endowment Fund

This fund was established by the Orillia YMCA to recognize and promote the legacy of an exceptional man, Skid Watson. This Fund is used each year to assist those children, single parents and adults that are in need of assistance with membership and program costs at the Orillia YMCA.
